



God of Recovery: Bringing Back Everything the Enemy or Circumstances Stole.

There are moments in our lives when we feel like something has been taken from us. And as a matter of fact, to some of us, something has indeed been taken from us. This could be time, opportunities, health, relationships, joy, and physical or spiritual inheritance.

1 Samuel 30:8 (KJV), *“And David enquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? Shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake them, and without fail recover all”.*

David was only asking for God’s assurance of overtaking or defeating his enemy. Still, God assured him that not only would he defeat his enemy, but he would also recover everything his enemy had stolen from him.

This month, by the power and the authority of God’s word, you will overtake, outrun, overpower, and subdue your enemy, and you will recover everything he has stolen from you.

Joel 2:25-26 (KJV), *“And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you...”.*

But my brothers and sisters, hear this clearly: Loss is only part of the journey of life; recovery is the destination. Recovery is part of your salvation package. Recovery is possible.



- What the enemy stole is not beyond God's reach.
- What has left you is still here on earth and it can still be recovered.

We serve a God who not only gives, but can restore **that which was stolen**. He does not only **heal**—He **recovers completely**.

Let us go through some key points regarding recovery and restoration.

1. GOD IS A SPECIALIST IN RECOVERY

In **Joel 2:25**, God didn't say, *"I will replace."* He said, *"I will restore."*

Restoration means:

- Bringing back what was lost.
- Repairing what was damaged.
- Releasing what was delayed.

God has the power and ability to restore your lost years, opportunities, strength, and identity.

The Lord says in **Isaiah 61:7 (KJV)**, *"For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore, in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them"*.



In Genesis 37-41, we read about Joseph and how he lost family, freedom, reputation, and time. But with one supernatural intervention by God, he was lifted from prison to palace.

Truth: The enemy may steal—but he cannot keep what belongs to God. Your life, destiny, and glory belong to God. God can restore, in one day, what has been lost for years.

And today, where you are seated, God is restoring everything that was lost in your life and family.

2. RECOVERY REQUIRES DIVINE DIRECTION, AND DIVINE DIRECTION IS OBTAINED WHEN YOU TARRY IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD

David did not act emotionally—he *inquired of the Lord*. My brothers and sisters, recovery is not random—it is revealed.

1 Samuel 30:8

Many believers are chasing what God did not direct them to chase. But when God gives direction, your effort becomes effective, and your pursuit becomes fruitful.

In **Psalm 32:8 (KJV)**, the Lord says, *“I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye”*.

Faith Anchor: When God gives direction, recovery is guaranteed. My brothers and sisters, by emotion, you can recover what you have lost. But when you tarry in the presence of God, He will give you instruction to overrun, overtake, and recover everything that the enemy has stolen from you.



3. TOTAL RECOVERY IS GOD'S WILL

TOTAL RECOVERY MEANS: Nothing missing. Nothing broken. And nothing left behind

1 Samuel 30:18-19

David recovered all... There was nothing lacking. Not partial. Not incomplete.

Truth is this: God's restoration is often greater than the original loss. The Bible says this about Job's losses:

Job 42:12-13 (KJV), *"So, the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses. He also had seven sons and three daughters".*

Don't lose hope because of your losses; total recovery is possible, and when God does, it comes with double what you lost.

4. GOD RESTORES NOT ONLY THINGS, BUT YEARS

Years and seasons can be impossible for men to recover, but not with God.

Joel 2:25

The locust didn't just eat crops—it consumed **time, seasons, and progress.**



But God said: **“I will restore the years...”** This means:

- Marital delay can be restored.
- Childbearing delay can be restored.
- Lost opportunities can be recovered.
- Wasted seasons can be redeemed.
- Hopeless situations can be revived.

Romans 8:28

Nothing waste in the hands of God. God has the power to use what seems to be a bad situation in your life for your good.

Faith Anchor: God can compress time and accelerate destiny.

5. THE ENEMY DOES NOT HAVE FINAL AUTHORITY

Yes, the enemy steals—but: He is not the owner. **He does not possess the final say or authority. Jesus disarmed principalities.**

John 10:10 | Colossians 2:14

Truth:

- What was illegally stolen from you can be recovered legally through Christ.
- What was taken from you by deception can be restored by the truth.



Jesus is the truth. And when He steps in, deception gives up what he has taken. So, seek and make sure that Jesus has the whole of you, not just as a visitor, but with His permanent place in your heart.

6. FAITH IS THE KEY TO ACTIVATING RECOVERY

Hebrews 11:1 (KJV), *“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen”*.

Recovery begins when you **believe!**

- Believe that your marriage can be restored.
- Believe again that you have a living, active womb ready to carry your baby.
- Believe that it is not over and that your health can return to a perfect stage.
- Believe that your destiny is not lost.
- Believe beyond every odd that you are better than what is around you and that you can rise, run, and cross the finish line ahead of those who had gone ahead of you.

Mark 11:23 | Mark 9:23 | Philippians 4:13

No matter how terrible the fall is, you can recover. No matter how long the delay has been, you can recover from it. No matter the pain of the failure and disappointment, you can recover and succeed.
